UPDATE - Unemployment Benefits – CARES Act (March 27, 2020)

The CARES Act has been enacted to enhance Unemployment Insurance benefits & stimulus package. The program will pay workers \$600 a week on top of the sum people receive in their state-level unemployment claim for up to four months. More info labor.ny.gov/unemploymentassistance
